- c) We can also use this / that / these / those without a noun.
 - What are these?
 - This is a nice bag.
- d) We use this and these to talk about things that are happening now or starting now.
 - I like this class. [You are in the classroom.]
- e) We use that and those to talk about things that **finished**.
 - I liked that class. [The class finished.]
- f) We can use *this* to **introduce people**.
 - This is my friend Alberto.
