



## VIDEO 1: AN INTERESTING CITY

### Video 1: An interesting city / town / village.

Record a 2-minute tik-tok / video presentation about an interesting city / town / village. It may be a place you know or a place you would like to visit in the future.

#### Say:

- Where the city/ town / village is located.
- Describe the special characteristics the city has (geography, weather, natural beauties, landmarks).
- Why you think this is a good place to visit.
- Mention anything else you think is important.

#### INSTRUCTIONS

- Your video must last 2 minutes, NO MORE, NO LESS. Adjust to the time.
- Make sure you answer all the points above.
- Make sure that you appear on the video. Your face should be noticeable.
- DO NOT READ.** Try to present your opinion. Take notes, but this is not a “reading aloud” test.
