



INTRODUCTION TO TYPES OF ESSAYS:



- Narrative Essay: Tells you a story or recount and event.
- Descriptive Essay: Provide detailed descriptions to paint a picture with words.
- Expository Essay: Explain or inform about a topic.
- Persuasive Essay: Convinces the reader to accept a particular viewpoint.
- Pros and Cons Essay:

 Discusses the advantages and disadvantages of a topic.

STRUCTURAL FEATURES



INTRODUCTION:

- Hook: An interesting opening to grab the reader's attention.
- Background Information: Brief context or background about the topic.
- Thesis Statement: A clear statement of the main point or argument of the essay.

BODY:

- Topic Sentences: Each paragraph starts with a sentence that introduces the main idea of the paragraph.
- Supporting Details: Evidence, examples, and explanations that support the topic sentence.
- Transitions: Words or phrases that help to connect ideas between paragraphs smoothly.

STRUCTURAL FEATURES



CONCLUSION:

- Restate Thesis: Restating the main point in different words.
- Summary of Main Points: Briefly summarizing the key points discussed.
- Closing Thought: A final thought or call to action.

BIBLIOGRAPHY:

 A list of sources cited in the essay, formatted according to a specific style guide (APA, MLA, Chicago, etc.).


