### **USED TO**

#### 1.1 **USE**

We use "used to" in English to talk about a habit, state, or action that was true in the past but is no longer true in the present. It describes something that happened regularly or existed over a period of time in the past but has since changed or ended:

I used to eat a lot of candy. (Now I don't do this.)

People used to smoke on airplanes. (Now this is prohibited.)

There weren't many people online in 1995. (Now there are.)

We use "used to" to describe past habits and repeated actions:

Mary used to play with her doll collection when she was little.

I used to practice the viola every day when I was in a children's orchestra.

We use "used to" to describe past states or situations:

There didn't use to be a supermarket here. (Now, there is.)

The Four Seasons used to be one of the most popular groups in the 60s.

We use "used to" to create a contrast between the past and the present:

She used to eat meat but she gave it up a few years ago.

There used to be huge dinosaurs walking around the earth.

### **1.2 FORM**

## "Used to" is always followed by the base form of the verb:

I used to drink sugary drinks.

We used to **sleep** more.

There used to **be** a garden here.

When using the negation form, treat "used to" as a past tense verb. Use "didn't use to":

The faculty **didn't use** to have a computer lab.

I didn't use to like tomatoes.

When using the question form, treat "used to" as a past tense verb. Use "did...use to...?":

Did you use to read more than now?

**Did most parents use** to treat their kids differently?

Do not confuse "used to" with "get used to" or "be used to"—these expressions have different uses and meanings.

I'm getting used to the new program.

The cat's not used to the new food.
