abroad this summer



FIRST CONDITIONAL



REGULAR
BEAUCHEFIAN

If I had the money, I would
travel abroad this summer



SECOND CONDITIONAL

If I had had the money, I
would have traveled abroad
last summer

Mixed conditionals

We sometimes mix second and third conditionals if a hypothetical situation in the past has a present / future consequence, e.g., *You wouldn't be so tired if you had gone to bed earlier last night.*

If he really loved you, he would have asked you to marry him.

Unreal Past condition-Present result

**If I had listened to my mom I
wouldn't be in trouble now**


If Clause (Condition)	Main Clause (Result)
If + Past Perfect	Present conditional (would + verb)

Past result- Unreal Present situation

**If they knew about his
problem, they would have
helped him**

If Clause (Condition)	Main Clause (Result)
If + Past Simple	Perfect conditional (would have + past participle)

*If Tim **hadn't overslept** on the train, he'd **be** with us now.*
